Prepare to be captivated by the enchanting alpine scenery, where breathtaking snowy vistas and tranquil frozen lakes await at every turn.

St. Moritz - Top of the World

St. Moritz – where glamour, lifestyle, sports and untamed nature come together in an exclusive cocktail. St. Moritz has demonstrated its pioneering spirit throughout the ages and is renown as the birthplace of Alpine winter tourism. Ski and snowboard areas include Corviglia, Diavolezza and Corvatsch, combined offering around 350 kilometres of pistes with a state-of-the-art infrastructure.

Corviglia is not just about the altitude, the many hours of sunshine and the spectacular panorama; Corviglia has an unrivalled history that includes the staging of two Winter Olympics (1928, 1948) and five FIS Alpine World Ski Championships (1934, 1948, 1974, 2003, 2017). Every day the uplifts start operating at 7.45 am, transporting snowsports enthusiasts to the 'white carpet'. The array of pistes, the Ski Run (giant slalom with time control) and the UYN Speedcheck (for speed photos), invite winter-sports fans of all levels to enjoy the outstanding slope conditions.

Corvatsch mountain on the other hand is famous for it has powder until the end of April. It is an El Dorado for freeski and freestyle-fans and in winter 2025 will jointly host the halfpipe and slopestyle events of the FIS Freestyle World Championships, together with Corviglia. Furthermore, every Friday night is Snow Night: a night when guests can ski on the longest illuminated slope in Switzerland. And last but not least, Mt. Diavolezza captivates with its stunning mountain panorama and the eight-kilometre glacier run that takes you down to Morteratsch under the watchful gaze of Piz Palü and Piz Bernina, as a highlight.

Davos Klosters - Sports unlimited

Between Mountain Magic and Magic Mountain Davos is the highest town in Europe, famed for the diversity of sports, leisu-

re and cultural offers, its rejuvenating climate, the HC Davos, the Spengler Cup, the Kirchner Museum, the World Economic Forum and the celebrated freestyle scene on Jakobshorn.


Pioneer in winter sports

Davos was at the forefront of the development of modern winter sports. The history of the world renowned Davos sledge started in the 19th century. The sledge received its name at the first historic sledge race in 1883, in Davos. In 1921 in Davos, the Hockey Club Davos was established and today it is akin to myth and living legend. 1923 witnessed the first Spengler Cup, the oldest and most famous international ice-hockey tournament in the world. The Parsenn Derby is the most traditional ski race in Switzerland and took place for the first time in 1924. Ten years later, the first t-bar ski lift in the world was put into operation on the Bolgen. In more modern times, Davos created headlines when it established the freestyle scene in the 1980s. At that time, the Jakobshorn was the only mountain on which snowboarders were permitted to use the lifts.

Having fun in 6 ski areas

Whether you are a piste fan or freeride pro: it's all downhill. Racy or leisurely, on skis or on the board and all this in the middle of the mountain world of Davos Klosters. Six skiing areas provide fun on the slopes at all levels of difficulty. But that's not all - not only the racy downhill runs are a highlight in themselves, but also the top modern lifts that make it easy to get uphill and die anew. It's up to you whether you use the perfectly groomed slopes or take one turn after the other through glittering powder.



Sunday, 2. March 2025

During the day

Individual arriving in St. Moritz, check-in at Hotel Laudinella. Individual arrival in St. Moritz. We suggest flying into Zurich Airport and taking trains, which takes about 3.5 hrs. From Zurich Airport, change trains at Zurich HB to either Landquart or Chur, then continue to St. Moritz Bahnhof. From there, take bus number 9 (7 min) to St. Moritz Bad Post, which is close to the Hotel Laudinella.

Train and bus schedules are available on the SBB.ch website or SBB app. Train and bus tickets can be purchased online in advance or at the SBB counter at Zurich airport.

Please insert St. Moritz Bad Post as final destination when buying ticket. Use Google Maps to find the hotel.

Check-in, pick up your Hotel Ski Pass ticket at the reception, and enjoy some free time until the program begins. If time allows, consider having lunch at the Hotel Laudinella restaurant, relaxing at the spa or ordering ski or snowboard equipment at rental stores in St. Moritz.

Ascent Muottas Muragl by funicular

The funicular Muottas Muragl was the first mountain railway in the canton of Grisons to open up a scenic mountain to tourists and that over 100 years ago.

Apéro on the sun terrace of Romantic Hotel Muottas Muragl

The winter fairytale begins with the ascent of the historic funicular through the snow-covered forest, followed by the breathtaking view over the Upper Engadin, which is completely covered in white. Below the frozen lakes, above the impressive mountain peaks, under your feet the crunching snow. What a setting to enjoy.





18.45 pm:

Welcome-Dinner and opening party with DJ at the Scatla – pront'à manger

"Pront' à manger" is Rhaeto-Romanic and means "ready to eat" in the local language. The Scatla inspires with an exciting contrast with its futuristic cube of glass and wood – a magnificent view of the Engadin mountains is guaranteed and it's the perfect place for private dinners and parties on Muottas Muragl.





22.15 pm*:

Descent with the funicular to Punt Muragl station

Transfer back to your hotel by public transport. Bus line 10 (night bus), from the bus station "Punt Muragl, Talstation" to the bus station "St.Moritz Bad, Hallenbad" nearby your hotel.

* Individual and earlier descents are possible. The funicular goes every 30 min (xx.15 and xx.45). The bus line 10 leaves at xx.23 and xx.53 in the direction of St. Moritz.

Meet Matteo at the Corvatsch valley-station and enjoy your first day on the slopes.

Mt. Corvatsch is famous for its fun park and for it has powder until the end of April. It is an El Dorado for freeski and freestyle- fans and in March 2025 will jointly host the halfpipe and slopestyle events of the FIS Freestyle World Championships, together with Corviglia.



12.00 pm:

We meet for lunch at the **restaurant "Kuhstall"**, an alpine cow-shed in summer, but refunctioned into a homely, cozy and unique restaurant in winter.



Until 15:30 pm:

Free skiing- and snowboarding; in the end take the "Hahnensee-Run", a slope that allows you to ski- or snowboard among the beautiful lake- scenery of the Engadin-valley, all the way down to the hotel in St. Moritz that you are staying. From the Giand d'Alva chairlift make sure to turn around, enjoy the great view and take some pictures.



Evening:

Free time to spend with your loved ones exploring the town of St. Moritz. We suggest going to the Ovaverva swimming pool.



Take the first cable car up to the ski area Corviglia

Skiing and snowboarding on Corviglia ski area

The White Carpet on Corviglia is a must for all skiing enthusiasts. What could be better than enjoying the first runs on the freshly groomed slopes?





This experience may cost a bit of self-discipline, but getting up early in the morning for irresistible first turns under the morning sun is definitely worth it! Leaning into every turn, gliding along the wide slope, letting your hand slightly graze the ground while your skis cut deep into the snow - a simply wonderful feeling here on the slopes of Corviglia. Don't miss our slope highlights: The UYN Speedcheck (speed measurement with photos), the Ski Run (giant slalom with timekeeping and video) and the 600-metre-long Skicross slope provide a lot of action.

12.00 am:

Lunch at the Restaurant Piz Nair 10000 Feet

High above at 3057 metres above sea level is your place for lunch. The Restaurant Piz Nair 10000 Feet with an impressive 360-degree view over the Upper Engadin stands for spectacular panorama and excellent cuisine.

Meeting point, bus station St. Moritz Bad, Hallenbad

(Please wear warm clothes, no skiing equipment)\$

Bus line 1, from the bus station "St. Moritz Bad, Hallenbad" nearby your hotel to the bus station "Pontresina, Post", change to Bus line 2 to Bernina Diavolezza, Bahnhof.

17.00 pm

Meet Matteo at Bernina Diavolezza train station, take the last cable car up together to Mt. Diavolezza

Mt. Diavolezza is famous for its beautiful mountain panorama at almost 3000 m.a.s.l., but also for its eight-kilometre glacier run that takes you down to Morteratsch under the watchful gaze of Piz Palü and Piz Bernina.



Official closing dinner on Mt. Diavolezza

After the closing of all the chairlifts, we will stay on the mountain-top and enjoy the quiet and peaceful atmosphere on top of Mt. Diavolezza, while night falls in and the stars start appearing in the sky. We will have a Goodbye-Dinner, including fun side-program.







Skiing and snowboarding on Jakobshorn or enjoy your free time at Bolgen Plaza or Jatzhut (biggest party hut on Jakobshorn) ski area (60 km slopes, steepest slope "1K vertical", freestyle Jatzpark, pipe)

Jakobshorn – Good vibrations on the freestyle mountain

At the top of the mountain, daredevils will find the «JatzPark» with four runs featuring 20 elements such as kickers and rails.

Enjoy your ride on the 50 km slopes or off piste or have a freestyle session in the Jatzpark with your local Therry Brunner, World Championship silver medalist. He was the first who managed a 1080° at Olympia in Turino 2006.

Beginners can also enjoy a relaxing time together at the foot of the Jakobshorn. The beginners' piste by the Carjöl two-person chairlift is perfect for those first attempts at gliding on the snow and later relax and sunbathe in one of the beach chairs.

In Davos it is also possible to have fun on the pistes, cross-country trails, ice fields and toboggan runs at night. But night skiing/snowboarding at Rinerhorn belongs to the supreme discipline.

Rinerhorn – a ski resort pleasure seekers: With 39 kilometres of slopes and the diverse offers on site, Rinerhorn boasts tons of fun and variety. The perfectly groomed, wide slopes are a great location for learning how to ski or practicing your carving turns.

Meet Fredi or your instructor in front of Parsenn cable railway, valley station.

Early bird skiing/snowboarding in Parsenn - First in powder or on the slopes

Enjoy an absolutely unique snow experience with your local guide. Realize your dream of being the first on the slope in the morning and leaving your mark on the freshly prepared slopes before the official opening time. Revel in the calm atmosphere of the morning and watch the sunrise on the breathtaking panorama of the Grisons mountains.

Breakfast at Restaurant Weisslfuhgipfel on 2844 m.a.s.l with an asthonisching view.

Ski and snowboard with your guide/ski instructor or on your own at Parsenn ski area (Davos side). On wide and long slopes, you will feel your legs in the evening. While alpine skiers and boarders enjoy the endless slopes, freestyler and freeriders will enjoy the playground next to the slopes or in the backcountry of this ski area.

Lunch at the igloo village.

During the opening hours of the slopes, the doors are open for igloo visits, bar visits with homemade mulled wine or fondues made of regional mountain cheese. The Igloo Village offers room for up to 46 overnight guests in the evening. Each of the 14 igloos is connected by a corridor system with restaurant and toilet.





01.30 pm:

Relax and enjoy the view on the mountain or continue skiing & snowboarding with your guided/skiinstructor and your group or on your own on Parsenn ski area.

01.30 pm

Ski or snowboard the longest run from Weissfluhgipfel on 2>844 m.a.s.l. down to Klosters on 1>200 m.a.s.l. is around 12 km long. A must for all winter sport enthusiasts. Take the Gotschna gondola back to Parsenn ski area or jump on the train from Klosters Platz back to Davos Platz (incl. with the lift ticket).

Skiing on Pischa (freeriders only!) or Parsenn (Klosters side) in the morning and change to Madrisa ski area in the afternoon. These slopes are very wide and up to 10 km long.

Pischa ski area has only one cable car, only for the good skiers and snow-boards looking for fresh powder snow, no groomed slopes!) with your guide or on your own.

Pischa is the hidden gem among the mountains of Davos Klosters and a popular destination for those wanting to enjoy the time away from the crowds. Freeride skiing and snowboarding and other activities like speed touring, snowshoeing and fat biking or airboarding are very popular on Pischa.





12.00 am

Lunch at restaurant Weissfluhgipfel (top of ski area) for campers at Parsenn/ Lunch at restaurant Mäderbeiz on Pischa mountain

Skiing down to Klosters Platz and taking the bus to enjoy Madrisa ski area in the afternoon.

On Madrisa mountain there are practice areas for beginners and children, The resort also has four practice lifts for children where the little ones can have fun while adults enjoy their time on 31 kilometres of slopes. Also for freeriders this small ski area is paradise. Plenty of runs into different valleys makes this place a secret spot for powder lovers.

Train transfer back to Davos from Klosters Dorf to Davos Dorf. Take the bus back to your hotel by your own.

Enjoy your last dinner at one of the best Chinese restaurant in Switzerland. After the delicious dinner we will party all night at the bar and later at the Pöschtli Club Davos.


